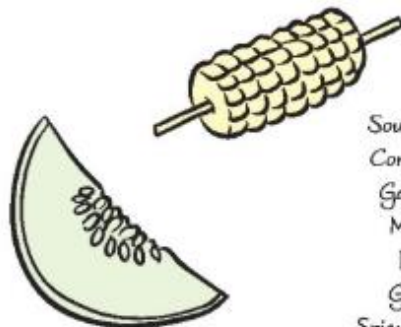
Welcome to Al Dontay's, where every meal is a feast!

Main Courses

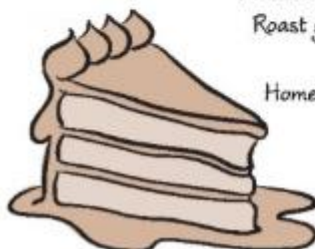
- Spaghetti bolognese – our chef's special recipe €9.85
